### **Apr Function: Introduction of China High Speed Train CRH3**

**Date: Monday 15<sup>th</sup> Apr 2013**

**Time: 6:30 pm to 7:30 pm**

**Venue: Theatre, 2/F, Fo Tan Railway House**

The High Speed Train service with maximum operating speed of 350 km/h in China commenced on 1 August 2008 on the Beijing-Tianjin Line, by a fleet of CRH3 trains. To date, CRH3 trains have been widely adopted on many major High Speed Lines in China including Beijing-Tianjin, Wuhan-Guangzhou, Shanghai-Beijing, Shanghai-Nanjing, Shanghai-Hangzhou, Zhengzhou-Wuhan, Zhengzhou-Xian, Harbin-Dalian and Guangzhou-Shenzhen Lines.

The scope of technical talk will include the design standards and performance aspects of CRH3 trains in achieving the high safety & reliability standards and the techniques adopted in achieving relatively lower Life cycle Cost.

#### Guest Speaker

Mr Albert Chui has 35 years of experience in rolling stock design and project management work. He has managed / been involved in many major rolling stock projects from conceptual stage, through feasibility study, specification preparation, tendering, project execution, test and commissioning to final acceptance, service development, design modifications, refurbishment and renewal, covering the full spectrum of work associated with rolling stock engineering.

From 1977 to 2002, he worked with three world class railway organisations in Hong Kong and Singapore. He was responsible for the procurement of EMUs for West Rail, East Rail and Ma On Shan Rail. He became a consultant since 2003 offering technical support services to many projects in China and other Asian cities.
