How the MTR network should be further expanded following completion of the 5 committed rail projects?

Representatives from the MTR Corporation are going to share with the participants the views and likely opportunities arising from the potential new railway lines identified under the Government's Update and Review of the Second Railway Development Study (RDS-2U) which has already undergone two stages of public consultation since last year.

The presentation will also touch upon some memories of rail development in Hong Kong, with focus on the strategic implications of the rail infrastructure to facilitate long term economic growth.
