About CHKRI

Railway is of paramount importance in being one of our major mode of transportation in the urbanized transportation network in Hong Kong. In 1979, Permanent Way Institution (Hong Kong Branch) was founded to organize technical forum and social gathering activities for its members and the railway practitioners in Hong Kong. With increasing exchanges between railway professionals from Hong Kong and Mainland China and support from the China Railway Society, the China Hong Kong Permanent way Society (CHKPWS) was established in 1998. In 2011, CHKPWS was re-named as China Hong Kong Railway Institution (CHKRI).

Abstract of Sharing Session

In order to attract more young talents to join the railway profession, we are pleased to have two young engineers Mr. Aaron Lam and Mr. Jim Chim to share with us their site visit experience in Europe upon being the awardees of the “MTR Young Engineer of the Year - Insurance Award”. They will share with us about their exposure in the project of the Rennes Metro and Tunnel Rastatt in France and Germany respectively. In the sharing session, the speakers would also provide us some updates on the use of Virtual Reality technology and TBM technology in overseas construction industry.

About the Speakers

Mr. Aaron Lam, who is currently Manager of the Station Retail business in MTR, joined the Corporation 8 years ago as a Graduate Engineer. In 2011-2017, he has dedicated his full involvement and participated in the steel roof construction of the High Speed Rail West Kowloon Station. Aaron then progressed to railway property development work in 2018 as Assistant Project Manager overseeing the Tseung Kwan O Lohas Park development.

Mr. Jim Chim, was a formerly construction engineer in MTR. He joined MTR as a Graduate Engineer 10 years ago. In 2009-2018, he devoted himself to the project of Kwun Tong Line Extension and Shatin-to-Central Link and was responsible for managing the works for Ho Man Tin Station and To Kwa Wan Station. He now works in Railway Development Office of Highways Department as an Engineer.
